Our Liturgy this Sunday includes our Ecumenical Covenant and visiting preachers.

**In Southport: "Better Together"** is our Southport gathering from more than 20 churches at 6.30pm in Leyland Rd Methodist church this Sunday evening: urging all who are called by God to serve increased unity to gather for prayer and solidarity in service.

Tuesday Morning Prayer Group continues weekly at 7.30am for an hour. This week Churches Together in Ainsdale invites us to join at 9.30am each day for prayers in the different churches, praying for aspects of Christian mission: see the front page.

**CTIA Covenant Committee** meets this Wednesday at 7.15 at Woodvale Chapel. Mike Thornber, Annette Wilkinson, Gerard Lavin and Valda Dilworth are our reps. **In the Archdiocese** evening prayer today is with both Bishops in the Anglican Cathedral at 3pm for Ecumenical Prayer, and Cardinal Michael Fitzgerald is speaking.

The Ecumenical Commission: Fr Tony is now a member and meets on 5<sup>th</sup> Feb with the Archbishop's team to further our Church's mission of Unity.

**Nationally** we join with all Christians at Pentecost time in praying the Our Father for 8days for healing of the wounds of history and increased Christian Unity.

When you need a priest urgently please ask the ward staff to call him. Eucharistic Ministers and Priests give generously of their time. In 2019 Catholic 3,588 patients were visited: around 300/month. The priests responded to 210 calls to the dying. It is uplifting that we are called to see so many people, which affirms our beliefs in Jesus, the Bread of Life and our Healer.
